**The revision of implementing the health measures and quarantine for diplomats and officials
of International Organizations holding Cambodian Diplomatic Visa (VisaA)**

The Inter-Ministerial Committee to Combat COVID-19 is honored to inform the Foreign Missions and International Organizations accredited to Cambodia that, with the reference to the high approval of **Samdech Techo Prime Minister** dated 18 December 2020 on the letter No.260 SKL dated 18 December 2020 of the Ministry of Health on the revision of implementing health measures and the full 14-day quarantine for diplomats and officials of International Organizations holding Cambodian Diplomatic Visa (VisaA) as the follows:

- Possess a health certificate issued by the health competent authorities, recognized by their residence countries indicating that negative for COVID-19 within the validity of 72 hours prior to the departure. Upon arrival into Cambodia, they are required to undergo through the sample collection for testing conducted by the Cambodia's medical professionals.
- Foreign Missions and teamworks of International Organizations accredited to Cambodia are required to strictly observe in implementing the full 14-day quarantine of the holders of Cambodian Diplomatic Visa (Visa A). In case any passengers are tested positive for COVID-19, the Ministry of Health will dispatch the patient of positive for COVID-19 to the designated hospitals of the Ministry of Health.
- Undertake the full 14-day quarantine at the Embassy or Isolated Residences. In the case of diplomats do not reside at the Embassy or Isolated Residences, they are subject to undertake the full 14-day quarantine at Himawari Hotel under the strict observation of their Missions and the health officials. All expenses shall be borne by the person concerned.
- They are not allowed to meet any guests during the full 14-day quarantine.
- The travel from the airport to the Embassy or Isolated Residences is required to use the means of transportations of the Embassies or International Organizations only.
